To celebrate the 20th anniversary of the Peaceful Revolution in Europe, MitOst initiates the International Journalist Award "1989-2009: Europe in Dialogue".

We seek contributions on the process of Europe growing together beyond outdated dividing lines between the East and the West. The year 1989 must thereby form the initial point for the description of current and upcoming developments in Europe.

Submissions are accepted by print and online journalists aged 18 to 35 of EU countries and, for the first time, its eastern neighbouring states and of the Russian Federation who have reported fairly and openly on the subject.

The international jury of media representatives and experts will nominate ten authors to be invited to the Berlin award ceremony in autumn 2009. The first three winners will be honoured with endowed prizes of 2,500, 1,500 and 1,000 euro.

In the city of the fall of the Wall, the nominees have the possibility to meet experienced journalists at their newsrooms and get acquainted with representatives of the political and cultural life. The best articles are to be published in an anthology in February 2010 that is to be presented with a media assisted campaign.

The contributions may be in the language of the respective country. However, journalists should be fluent in English and German. Required is an appearance in a print or an online publication after August 2008. Please include to your submission the article in its original publication with the date of issue, the article in German translation and the filled-in entry form. If applicable for the article, add print quality pictures.

Deadline for submissions is **20 August 2009**.
